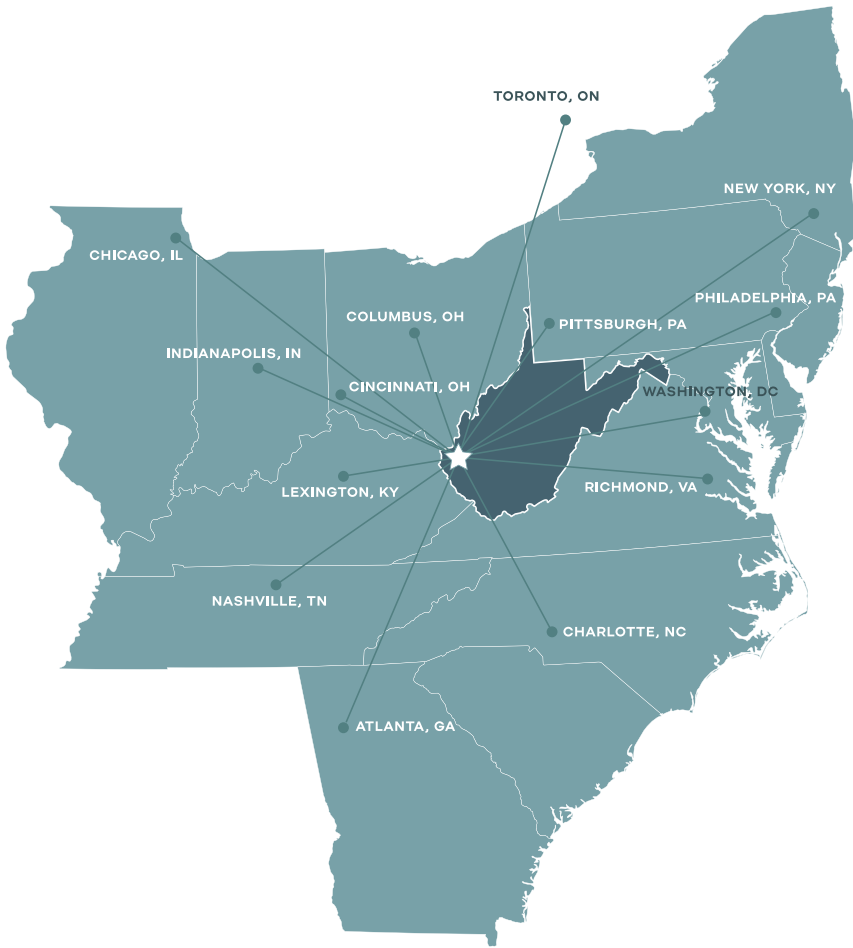

Keith-Albee Performing Arts Center

A true community gem and one of West Virginia's most iconic landmarks.

Since opening in 1928, the center has hosted national and local productions, film festivals, benefits, weddings and corporate events. Elevate your event with the stunning ambiance of Spanish Baroque architecture, featuring stained glass lighting and a blend of Moorish and Spanish decor.

- **Capacity:** 2,212
- **Amenities:** Twelve dressing rooms across four levels. Each dressing room is equipped with mirrors, lights, sinks, showers, toilets and wardrobe racks.
- Catering is allowed with theatre approval.

Heritage Farm

- **Venue Options:** Heritage Hall (Up to 150 people), Pioneer Hall (Up to 64 people), Barn Retreat Center: 19th-century converted dairy barn with multipurpose rooms, a large kitchen and bunk and bath areas (Up to 32 people)

21 at The Frederick

Amenities: Valet parking, airport shuttle, outdoor pool, fitness center and on-site restaurant.

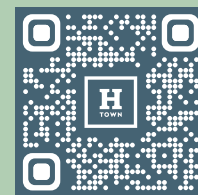
Delta by Marriott Downtown Huntington:

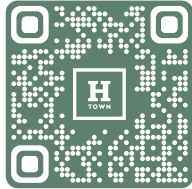
